| Management Control System | ➤ | Develop and implement Norms and Standards for the industry. Develop and implement a Lion Biodiversity Management Plan | ➤ | Create an industry standard that the operation of any facility can be measured against. Non-compliance can be addresses |
| Traceability | ➤ | Develop and implement a platform to capture data on every animal – compulsory | ➤ | Will assist in managing, regulating the industry. Will ensure tracing animal from cradle to grave. Non-compliance – no permits |
| Accreditation | ➤ | Minister needs to give administration rights to SAPA. Self-regulation of the industry through: - Accreditation / certification - Norms and Standards - Training - Audit system | ➤ | Every facility needs to be accredited before any permits can be renewed or issued. Noncompliance – no permits |

Regulation



On any standing permit application (new or renewal) compliance to norms and standards and LMBP is compulsory accredited membership compulsory



Non-compliance with 24-month grace period offered will result in voluntary exit of out of the industry

PROPOSAL TO REGULATE AND 'CLEAN' THE INDUSTRY AND ASSIST WITH VOLUNTARY EXIT



Male & Female registered on data base



Cub is born and naturally weaned to stay with female until age of 4 months
(no hand raising allowed)



When cub and female are separated, the cub receives a microchip that is registered on the data base; this ensures traceability



No permit for any movement can be issued without authorization from administrator operating data base




Permit to taxidermy and export of derivatives/trophy needs to be captured and authorized by administrator



No hunting permit without permission from administrator



No transport permit to hunting area/breeding farm/sanctuary without administrator permission and transport details



Final destination and all paperwork relating to a specific lion to be scanned and added to data base before archived. Traceable from birth until utilized.
